5 facts about water

- 1. An average beer consists of 90% water.
- 2. The water profile is decisive for the beer style. For example, you can brew good Pilsner beers with soft water.
- 3. The proportions of calcium and magnesium are mainly responsible for the water hardness.
- 4. Many breweries condition their beer. Lactic acid, sour malt, lime and magnesium are used in some cases.
- 5. Water treatment is permitted under the German Purity Law.
