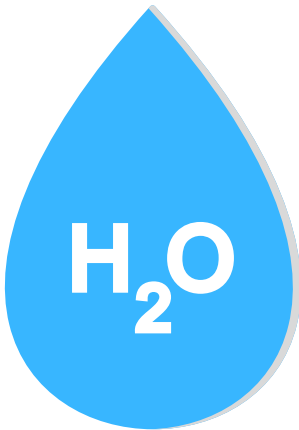


The largest part of a beer consists of water. But not all water is the same and so the water also has a certain influence on the quality of the beer

5 facts about water

1. An average beer consists of 90% water.
2. The water profile is decisive for the beer style. For example, you can brew good Pilsner beers with soft water.
3. The proportions of calcium and magnesium are mainly responsible for the water hardness.
4. Many breweries condition their beer. Lactic acid, sour malt, lime and magnesium are used in some cases.
5. Water treatment is permitted under the German Purity Law.
