Facts

The stout has always been very closely associated with the porter, but it is always a little stronger than a porter. Stout sounds similar to strong and so there were, among others, stout porters in the early 19th century. In the meantime, however, stouts are a style in their own right, but they are divided into numerous sub-styles.

From their roast profile, stouts are stronger than porters, but also bring many coffee - & cocoa notes. In general, stouts are already very dark and bring a full body.

Stouts have slightly fruity hop notes, but these are not very apparent in the strong stout.
